Partnering with community organizations, middle schools, high schools and colleges, the program engages and empowers youth to collectively choose and fund nonprofit organizations that are addressing the most pressing community and societal needs.

This January, 13 schools and organizations will embark on a 10-week curriculum to teach youth about the role nonprofit organizations play in our society, how to evaluate their effectiveness, measure their impact, and the overall importance of being active citizens and participants in their own communities.
