Now accepting proposals for 2012 Community Impact Consultants

Highland Street Foundation is now accepting proposals for its 2012 Community Impact Consultants program, which offers six-month consulting engagements to selected nonprofit organizations. In order to be eligible, nonprofits must be based in Massachusetts, be a 501(c)3, and have an operating budget between \$500,000 and \$2 million. Organizations will be selected based on their ability to demonstrate a specific need which can be addressed in a six-month timeframe.



Deadline for proposals is 5:00 p.m. on December 2nd.
